Committee grade will count for 5% of the total citizenship grade.

Students will receive 20 points each day. If they are marked off in any of the areas during the day, they will lose 5 points for each occurrence.

Negative points will roll over if they exceed 20 in one day. Days will be averaged for 95% of the final grade.

Students with major infractions will have their citizenship grade lowered two grades for the quarter.

Students will be excused for five absences in a quarter. After the fifth absence, zeros will be given for citizenship on days a student is absent.
