

# **The Six Critical Components of the Response to Intervention Model**

## 1. Initiate Universal Screening

- Give to children 3 X year
- Pinpoint early academic difficulties

## 2. Measure the Problem Areas

- Develop a plausible hypothesis
- What's your best assumption
- Avoid over simplification, anecdotal and opinion data

## 3. Establish Baseline Data

- Use curriculum-based measurements
- Review data for the class, school and district

## 4. Write and Accountability Plan

- DO NOT go back and try the same practices using the same materials that you have been using and expect the student to perform differently.

## 5. Monitor Progress

- An ongoing systematic process should be used to collect: Academic Data, Social Data, and Behavioral Data.

## 6. Compare Data

- Pre-intervention data to Post-intervention data
- Always share and show the data with parents
