State Board to meet June 15 and 16 in Juneau

The State Board of Education & Early Development will meet June 15 and 16, 2006, at the State Board Room at 801 West 10th Street in Juneau. The meeting will start at 8 a.m. each day.

Business meeting topics include possible adoption of the following proposed regulations:

- Repeal the requirement for pre-elementary school employees and elementary and secondary school district employees to obtain tuberculin skin tests.
- Clarify at what age a student with a disability may be included in a school district's average daily membership.
- Repeal 4 AAC 05.040, which pertains to the establishment of local schools, and 4 AAC 05.050, which pertains to requests that no local secondary school or only a partial school program be established.
- Revise the edition date of, and incorporate by reference, the Alaska Teacher Performance Review Handbook and Scoring Guide.
- Add a regulation setting corrective actions for school districts that are designated for corrective action under the No Child Left Behind Act.
- Address procedures for complaints regarding a district's or the state's administration of the No Child Left Behind Act.
