State Board to meet July 24 by teleconference

The State Board of Education & Early Development will hold a teleconferenced meeting at noon on July 24, 2006.

The board will consider setting the proficiency scores for the new tenth-grade standards-based assessment, amending the passing scores for the high school exit exam, and establishing regulations for district-operated statewide residential educational programs.

The meeting site will be at the Department of Education & Early Development, in the Commissioner's Conference Room on the second floor of the Goldbelt Building, at 801 West 10th Street in Juneau.
