## State Board to Meet July 25 by Audio Conference

JUNEAU -- The State Board of Education and Early Development will hold a special meeting on July 25 by audio conference, originating from the first-floor board room at 801 West 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Juneau. The meeting will begin at 2:00 p.m.

The purpose of the meeting is to hold a work session and a business meeting. The work session includes an update from Commissioner Dr. Michael Johnson on department activity. The business meeting focuses on the adoption of proposed regulation changes related to assessment achievement level scores on the Performance Evaluation for Alaska's Schools (PEAKS) assessments in grade 9 math.

The board will take public comment on agenda and non-agenda items starting at approximately 2:10 p.m. Oral comment is limited to three minutes per person and five minutes per group.
