State Board Receives COVID-19 Education Updates

JUNEAU – The State Board of Education and Early Development, meeting virtually on December 9, engaged in discussions regarding the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and its impacts on Alaska's schools.

The board received a medical update from leadership with the Department of Health and Social Services. The superintendent of Mt. Edgecumbe High School shared information on current COVID-19 mitigation measures, student successes, and continued challenges for teaching and learning. The director of the Division of Libraries, Archives, and Museums shared examples of how staff have adjusted public services in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In addition to standing reports from department staff, the board received an update on the 2020-2021 school enrollment student count. The board also engaged in a discussion regarding the Mt. Edgecumbe High School endowment and potential land sales.

Lastly, the board approved its annual draft report to the Legislature and the minutes from the June 10-11, 2020 board meeting, September 16-17, 2020 board meeting, and October 21, 2020 work session.
