State Board Appoints Acting Commissioner, Sends Assessment Cut Scores Regulations to Public Comment

JUNEAU – Today the Alaska State Board of Education & Early Development appointed Heidi Teshner as Acting Commissioner of the Department. Teshner was previously Deputy Commissioner and has 19 years of experience with the Department of Education & Early Development.

Teshner will serve as Acting Commissioner until the Board selects the next Commissioner of the Department. Unlike other State of Alaska departments, the Commissioner of the Department of Education & Early Development is selected by the State Board and subject to the approval of the Governor.

The Board also voted to send regulations for assessment cut scores out for public comment for both the AK STAR and Alaska Science Assessment. Cut scores are used to set the parameters of assessment achievement categories. For both assessments, new terms used for achievement categories are Advanced, Proficient, Approaching, and Needs Support.

The Board also approved the minutes of the June 8-9, 2022 meeting.

The Board's next scheduled meeting is a regular quarterly meeting, in-person in Sitka on September 6-7, 2022.
