

**4 AAC 33.520. General eligibility.** An eligible school in a district must

(1) enroll students in any combination of grades kindergarten through grade 12, except that a school that enrolls students in grades 11 and 12 only is not eligible for a school performance incentive payment;

(2) provide instruction in mathematics and language arts;

(3) administer to students state standards-based assessments in the statewide student assessment program under 4 AAC 06.737 - 4 AAC 06.739; a school that does not administer state assessments under 4 AAC 06.737 - 4 AAC 06.739 must enroll students that feed into a school that administers state assessments to its students; a school that feeds students into a school that administers state assessments must, or the school's district must, be able to track in whole number or fractionally a student who transfers to the receiving school; and

(4) meet at least a school-wide 95 percent participation rate separately on the reading test, the writing test, and the mathematics test for students enrolled on the first day of the test administration on the state standards-based assessments for the current school year [AND FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR].
