Description of Services:

Alaska Learning Labs is a summer school tutoring program, which is free to you and your child. We help your child do better in school. If you choose Alaska Learning Labs, your child will receive 2 or more hours of tutoring 5 days per week, that are fun and specific to your child's needs.

Your child will have a program designed based on test scores, teacher input, and family input. The program includes Compass Learning Odyssey. This award-winning computer program has reading and math lessons. Your child will also have lots of opportunities to read books including fiction and non-fiction and play math games that help with learning skills like place value, addition, subtraction, and math vocabulary.

Your child earns points by doing math and reading during the free tutoring sessions. Children then use the points earned to go shopping in our online store for items such as school supplies, personal care items, games, electronics, and more!

Alaska Learning Labs uses pre and post-tests aligned to our State's standards. Last year, 23 students, ages 5-11 who participated in Alaska Learning Labs free summer tutoring programs for at least 37 ½ hours improved in reading and math by more than one grade level. Parents and students are surveyed every year, and results show that children love the program and parents believe their children are doing better in school because of the program.

The Alaska Learning Labs (AKLabs) is a program of SERRC, Alaska's Educational Resource Center, a non-profit agency providing educational services to school districts throughout the state for 35 years.
