Description of Services:

Brain Hurricane's Kindergarten through 8th grade tutoring-program is different from other programs because Brain Hurricane uses interactive activities and lessons to teach math and reading, either on computers or in small group settings, in a FUN way!

After a long day in school, Brain Hurricane believes the best way to keep students interested in learning is to make learning fun and collaborative, while still having the content be aligned to state standards. Brain Hurricane's curriculum is aligned to Alaska Performance Standards (Grade Level Expectations). All Students are pre-tested using a diagnostic test that is directly aligned to Alaska Performance Standards. The results of the pre-test specifically identify which content areas the child is performing poorly in so that tutoring sessions can be individualized for each student. At the end of the program, a post-test is given to measure the overall gains of the student. Progress reports are given to parents, teachers, principals, and district officials every 10 hours of service.

Brain Hurricane has provided service to over 30,000 students throughout the United States since 2002. Studies have shown that students who participate in the Brain Hurricane Program show gains of about 30% in both math and reading. In addition, 90% of parents surveyed said that the Brain Hurricane program improved their child's math and/or reading skills.

Brain Hurricane's instructional staff includes local certified teachers, highly qualified paraprofessionals, and well-trained aides that work together to ensure that the program is administered effectively.

The program ends with a celebration of learning where students get to demonstrate what they have learned during the program to parents, tutors, and teachers. Students are awarded prizes for attendance and improved academic performance.
